Dear Premier McGuinty & Mr. Glass,

On behalf of myself and many concerned constituents, I am writing to recommend that you protect the 36-hectares of land east of the Eramosa Karst in upper Stoney Creek by allocating it as parkland. This is an important piece of land to Hamilton and Stoney Creek and it should be protected from development.

I appreciate the province's 2006 transfer of 73-hectares of karst lands to the Hamilton Region Conservation Authority, but the adjacent 36-hectares of land must not be overlooked. These lands contain an integral feeder system to the karst features.

Having visited the Eramosa Karst, I have come to understand the unique topography of the land and recognize that it deserves protection from development. Please give consideration to this long-term public interest and transfer the remaining 36-hectares of land east of the Eramosa Karst to the Hamilton Region Conservation Authority.
